The Course in Advanced Trauma Nursing-II:
A Conceptual Approach to Injury and Illness

Location: Baylor University Medical Center, Dallas, Texas (*map and classroom info. will be sent with book/confirmation letter*)

Course Description: *CATN-II* is a 2 day course which reinforces the psychophysiologic concepts central to trauma nursing. The course uses case studies to help discern commonalities among clinical problems, determine priorities of care, and establish criteria to evaluate ongoing clinical conditions. It benefits nurses who care for patients throughout the trauma continuum. There is no exam or verification process in this course.

Prerequisites: *CATN-II* may be officially attended by Registered Nurses (RNs). Other health care professionals may attend the course as auditors on a space available basis. It is recommended that course participants:

- Have completed the Trauma Nursing Core Course (provider).
- Have at least a minimum of two years of clinical nursing experience in emergency or critical care nursing.

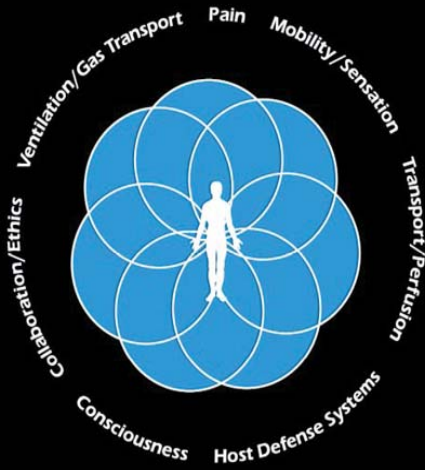
